Day 1 and 2 USA to the Holy Land

Your spiritual pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA on an overnight flight. You will be welcomed to the Holy Land by our airport representative and transferred to your hotel. Travel to the countryside of the Galilee. Enjoy dinner before you rest overnight in your Galilee hotel, connected to a local kibbutz. The kibbutz was one of the keys to Israel's development as a culture and country.

Day 3 Mt. Arbel, Nazareth, Mount of Precipice, Nazareth Village, Sepphoris

Travel to Mount Arbel and walk along its peak for a stunning view of the Sea of Galilee and the area in which Jesus ministered, with extended views of Mt. Hermon in the north and Mt. Tabor in the south. It is a magnificent photo opportunity. Visit Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus (Matthew 2: 23) and the Mount of Precipice where Luke describes how Jesus was rejected by those in the synagogue after He taught them. Filled with anger they "led him unto the brow of the hill whereon their city was built, that they might cast him down headlong" (Luke 4: 29). Explore the Nazareth Village, a living presentation of the life, times, and teachings of Jesus of Nazareth. Visit Sepphoris, the cosmopolitan Roman capital of Galilee until Herod Antipas built Tiberias. It is heralded as the traditional birthplace of Mary.

Day 4 Hazor, Tel Dan, Caesarea Philippi, Mt. Hermon and the Golan Heights

Explore Hazor, one of the oldest archaeological sites in Israel. The 3000 year old city was the inspiration for The Source, James Michener's epic history of the region. Here, Joshua fought against Jabin (Josh. 11: 1-11). Hazor was later fortified by Solomon. At nearby Tel Dan, see the mud brick arch constructed in pre-Israelite (Canaanites) times and where The House of David fragment-from the First Temple Period-was discovered. Visit Caesarea Philippi, where Jesus traveled with His disciples and where nearby Peter made his great confession to Jesus, "Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Matt. 16: 16). Continue on to Mount Hermon, probably the site of the Lord's Transfiguration (Matt. 17: 1-9). Travel on through the strategic tableland known as the Golan Heights. JEEP RIDE in GOLAN

Day 5 Nof Ginnosar, Mt. of Beatitudes, Capernaum, Kursi, Bethsaida

Watch the sunrise over the Sea of Galilee where fishermen work the waters with nets much as in the time of Jesus. Ride across the waters to explore Capernaum, the center of Jesus' ministry. Visit the synagogue which stands on the site where Jesus taught. Recall his teaching and preaching the gospel of the kingdom (Matt.4:13, 23). Visit the peaceful Mount of Beatitudes which over-

looks the Sea of Galilee. On this hill, Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount. Not far away is Bethsaida where Jesus chose five of his disciples (Matt. 4: 18-21; John 1: 39-51). On the far shore of the sea is Kursi where Jesus cast out evil spirits from a demon-possessed man and cast them into a group of swine which ran violently down a steep hill and drowned in the sea (Mark 5: 1-13). At Kibbutz Nof Ginnosar, you will learn about the "Ancient Boat", a rare example of the kind of boat in which Jesus would have sailed.

Day 6 Yardenit Baptismal Site, Beit Shean, Gideon's Spring, Mt. Gilboa, Megiddo

At the Yardenit Baptismal site, situated where the Jordan River flows out of the Sea of Galilee on its way to the Dead Sea, enjoy the peace and tranquility of the natural surroundings and participate in a baptismal service in the river in which Christ was baptized by John the Baptist (Mark 1: 9-11). Travel to the ruins of Beit Shean where the bodies of Saul and his sons were displayed on the walls there after they were killed in battle (1 Sam. 31: 10,12). Beit Shean is also noted for having the best-preserved ancient Roman theatre in Israel. Also visit Gideon's Spring (Ein Harod) where Gideon chose his army of 300 by observing how they drank from the springs (Jd. 7). The spring is in the shadow of Mt. Gilboa where Saul fought and died. His death made David lament and pray that no dew would fall on the mountain (2 Sam. 1:19-27). You will view the mountain and see that, to this day, Mt Gilboa is bare of trees. Travel the ancient caravan route to Tel Megiddo where 20 different cities lie superimposed upon each other, and where Solomon built his stables.

Day 7 Caesarea

Visit Caesarea, where you will see the ancient Roman aqueduct and theatre. Here, Cornelius became the first Gentile

convert to the new covenant (Acts 10) and Paul was imprisoned before taken to Rome for trial (Acts 23).

Day 8 Jerusalem, Mt. of Olives, Bethlehem, Mt. Zion, Upper Room, City of David, Garden of Gethsemane

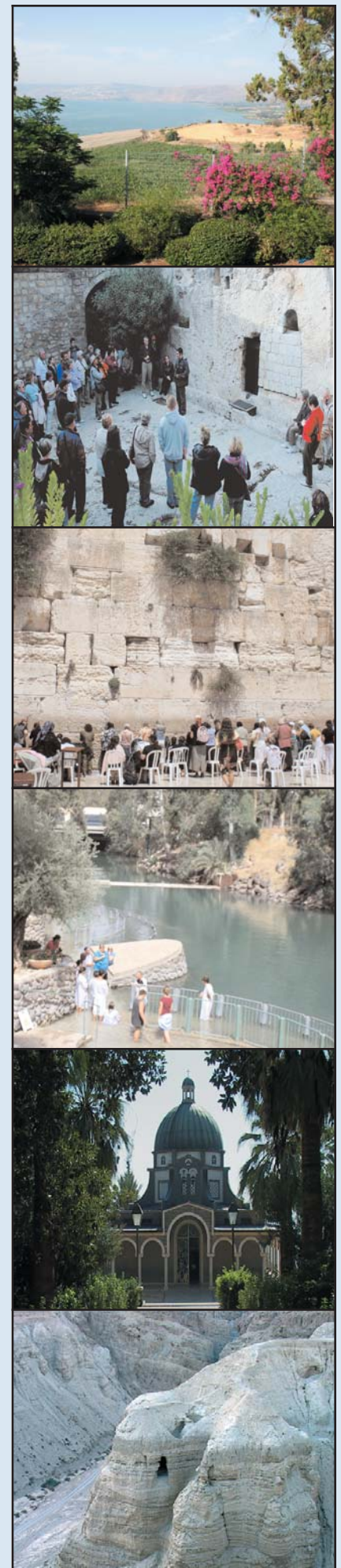
In Jerusalem, view Hezekiah's Tunnel, walk to the Garden of Gethsemane via the Kidron Valley and pray there as Jesus prayed (Matt. 26: 36-44). Stand atop the Mount of Olives as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem. Forty days after His resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives (Acts 1: 9-12). On Mount Zion view the site of King David's Tomb. Stand on the steps of the Pool of Siloam, where Jesus healed the blind man (John 9). Stand in the Upper Room, revered as the site of the Last Supper (Mark 14: 12-26). In Bethlehem, visit the cave where Jesus was born and the church, which has been constructed on the site (Matt. 1: 18-25; Luke 2: 1-7). Nearby, view the Shepherds' Field where the Good News was first heard.

Day 9 Southern Wall Excavations, Teaching Steps, Western Wall, Pool of Bethesda, Via Dolorosa, Garden Tomb

Visit the Davidson Center and the Southern Wall Excavations including the Teaching Steps and the Western Wall. View the Pool of Bethesda (John 5: 1-31) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle. Visit Herod's Antonia Fortress where Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23: 1-11). Walk the Via Dolorosa, the "Way of the Cross", and stand in reverence at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Visit the Garden Tomb, the possible site of the garden of Joseph of Arimathea, and experience the reality of the Resurrection.

Day 10 Return to the USA

Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this brochure. While you will see all sites listed above, the order of sites and/or days and number of days may be altered to accommodate changes in airline, hotel schedules, and local conditions. Due to airline schedules, some participants may receive one or two extra leisure days at a nominal per day charge.

PAYMENT: A full deposit of \$300 per person is required. Final payment for trip, including optional travel protection premium if applicable, is due 105 days prior to departure. Thereafter, a late payment fee of \$100 will be assessed. EOT reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 5% against the Israel Shekel based on foreign exchange rates in effect on SEPTEMBER 1, 2009.

SAVINGS: Early registration discounts are not available to Hosts/Co-Hosts and are deducted from the balance of your bill. An additional \$40 Savings available if full payment is received via check 4 months prior to departure.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Price is based on double occupancy. When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While EOT will try to match roommates, EOT cannot guarantee a roommate will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 35 days prior to departure and, if one is not available or you request a single room, the following charges apply: \$498 during the TOUR.

ITINERARY CHANGES: If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$90 per night; single rooms \$150 per night. Meals for extra nights are not included.

CANCELLATION FEES: 100% of Cancellation Fees are covered by the optional Travel Protection Program provided premium has been paid and reason for cancellation is insurable. Those who do not take travel protection should be aware of the following cancellation penalties: From day of registration to 105 days prior to departure, you will be charged the \$90 non-refundable administrative fee plus any airline fees. Additionally, thereafter, you will be charged any airline penalties and a single room supplement if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single plus the following charges: 104-60 days = \$400; 59-45 days = \$600; 44-31 days = 40% of total cost; 30 days to day of departure = 100% of total cost. In addition, cancellation fees for Luxor and Nile Cruise are: 59-31 days = 25% of extension cost; 30-0 days = 100%. Submit cancellation in writing. On or after day of departure, no refund for any services not used.
