# *Holy Land via Jordan...*

## **Day 1 and 2 USA to the Holy Land**

Your spiritual pilgrimage begins as you depart on your international flight. You will be welcomed to Amman, Jordan by our representative and transferred to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

## **Day 3 (TH 10/22) Petra**

Travel south from Amman for a visit to the famous Rock City of Petra. Just getting to Petra is an adventure. You'll ride a horse or carriage to the Siq, the long, narrow entrance into Petra. Once there, you'll marvel at the rose-colored rock and extensive carving. A whole city was literally cut into the cliff sides. Look out over the Promised Land like Moses from the top of Mt. Nebo (Deuteronomy 34), where on a clear day you can see a vast portion of Israel. Return to Amman for overnight.

## **Day 4 (FR 10/23) Jerash to Jerusalem**

This morning you will explore Jerash, one of the best-preserved Roman cities in the world. Stroll through the oval piazza and wander along colonnaded streets etched by the wheels of ancient chariots. Stand in the grand theatre where an onstage whisper can be heard in the top row. Later in the day, you will cross the King Hussein Bridge into Israel. Travel along the Jordan River Valley to Qumran, site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery, to discuss the mysterious community of the Essenes who once lived on the shores of the Dead Sea. Stand atop the Mount of Olives as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem, including the Temple Mount and Dome of the Rock. Visit the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus prayed for God's will to be done (Matthew 26). Forty days after his resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives (Acts 1). You'll visit the Chapel of the Ascension. Stand in the Upper Room, revered as the site of the Last Supper (Mark 14). Mt. Zion is also where you'll see King David's Tomb. Visit the House of the High Priest Caiaphas (Matthew 26) where Jesus was imprisoned for a night.

## **Day 5 (SA 10/24) Jerusalem**

Enter the Old City and visit the Southern Wall Excavations of the Temple including the Teaching Steps and the Western Wall. See the Temple Mount, once the site of the Temple of Solomon. View the Pool of Bethesda (John 5) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle, and sing a hymn in the Church of St. Anne. Walk the Via Dolorosa, "the Way of the Cross", and stand in reverence at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Continue through the Jewish Quarter, where modern buildings tower over excavations that date to the Judean Monarchy. See the Burnt House, where the remains of Jewish families' homes from the time of the Roman destruction of Jerusalem in 70 AD can be seen. Learn more about the Temple and Jewish rituals at the Temple Institute, where replicas of the instruments used are displayed. Follow the Herodian Support Wall and walk on First Century pavement in the Rabbi's Tunnel.

## **Day 6 (SU 10/25) Jerusalem**

Visit the Baptismal Site at Kasr el Yehud, the traditional site of the baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist. Journey to the oasis of Ein Gedi, where David and his men sought refuge from Saul (1 Samuel 23). Stop briefly at the Shores of the Dead Sea for a quick dip in the salt and mineral laden waters. Pass through the Judean Wilderness, thought to have inspired the 23rd Psalm.



### **Day 7 (MO 10/26)**

Visit Bethany, the home of Lazarus, Mary and Martha. Here Jesus visited on several occasions, and raised Lazarus from the dead (John 11). See the Archaeological study being done at Emek Tzurim, where excavations from under the Temple Mount are being studied. Travel to see the Chagall Windows at the Hadassah-Hebrew University Medical Center. Walk the museum and grounds of Yad Vashem, the Holocaust Museum, as a reminder of why we must never let this happen again. Wander the excavations of the City of David. Walk the steps to the Pool of Siloam, recently uncovered at the foot of the City. Explore Hezekiah's Tunnel, an amazing engineering feat that was dug from either end and met in the middle! (Note: Those who are claustrophobic may want to meet the group at the other end of the tunnel!).

### **Day 8 (TU 10/27)**

Visit and worship at the Garden Tomb, possible site of the garden of Joseph of Arimathea and experience the reality of the Resurrection. Walk the Emmaus Road where Jesus appeared to two travelers on the evening of the resurrection (Luke 24). Continue your journey through the Valley of Elah where David defeated Goliath (I Samuel 17). Travel the ancient caravan route to Tel Megiddo where 20 different cities lie superimposed upon each other. Travel to Nazareth, his boyhood home (Luke 26-56). Remember your baptism at the Yardenit Baptismal site, where the Jordan River exits the Sea of Galilee on its journey southward (Matthew 3).

### **Day 9 (WE 10/28)**

Travel to Mount Arbel and walk along its peak for a stunning view of the Sea of Galilee and the area in which Jesus ministered, with extended views of Mt. Hermon in the north and Mt. Tabor in the south. With your Bible in hand, cross the waters of the Sea of Galilee aboard a Kinnereth Sailing Company boat. Along the way, you will enjoy a special on board worship service. You'll arrive in Capernaum, where Jesus chose to center his ministry. Visit the synagogue site where Jesus most certainly taught and worshiped (Matthew 4; Mark 3 & 8). At Tabgha, you'll visit the Church of the Fish and the Loaves (Luke 9). Travel to the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus preached to the people (Matt. 5-7). Return to Amman for dinner and overnight.

### **Day 10 (TH 10/29) Return to USA**

Return to the United States with memories of the people and places of the Holy Land!

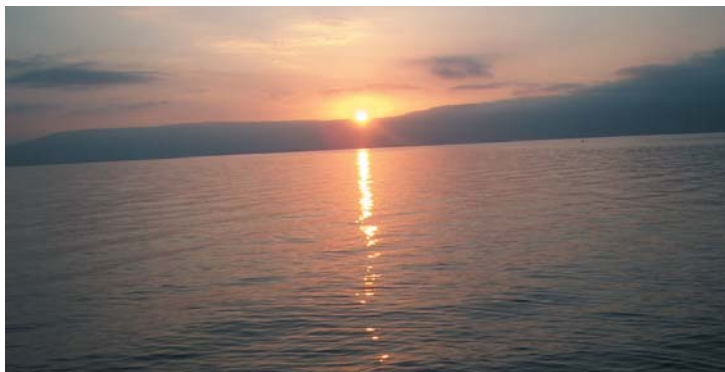

**ITINERARY CHANGES:** If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$90 per night; single rooms \$130 per night. Meals for extra nights are not included.
